The Congregation of the Passion, Holy Cross Province Communications Vision Fulfillment Team Minutes May 13, 2020

- We need to continue to share education.
- We need to continue to evangelize.
- We should see if there are some services, rather than hired employees, that could assist us in marketing and IT.
- We need to look at a marketing initiative.
- We cannot be complacent.
- We need people to understand who the Passionists are.
- We cannot be fearful of failure or success.
- There needs to be education to our Passionist Family of the wider Congregation, Configurations, Provinces, etc.

The Team then discussed what possible project proposals could be presented at the June Assembly. It was agreed upon that the Team would look at the following five:

- Information Technology Assessment
- Education of Information Technology
- Education of Marketing
- Education of Inreach and Outreach
- Education to understand the Passionist Congregation

Keith reminded the Team that the project proposals are due by Friday, May 29. Keith will send out the above five project proposals to the Team on the required Assembly submission form. He asked the Team to begin identifying what Resource Groups would be responsible for the above project proposals and to begin drafting the description of each project.

The Team will discuss the project proposals in greater detail at their next meeting.
