October 6, 2020 Laudato Si' Vision Fulfillment Team minutes

Present: Claire, David, Lissa, Patty Absent: Alex, Marta, and Tim Prayer: Lissa shared a prayer by Pope Francis from Laudato Si'.

Updates:

Those present reflected on our work together in light of Pope Francis' prayer.

Minutes:

The September 29, 2020 meeting are posted in our googledocs folder.

Sustainability Audits Process:

Our Team will meet with Sr. Corinne Sanders, OP, Director of Sustainability for the Adrian Dominican Sisters at our regular meeting time on Tuesday, October 27, 2020. We agreed that the meeting would be extended to 1 ½ hours. Lissa will comment on the Adrian Dominicans' enactment, specifically the use of the word "sacrifice": "We will sacrifice to mitigate significantly our impact on climate change and ecological degradation."

We brainstormed the following questions for Sr. Corinne:

- 1. How did you work with people who were set in their ways?
- 2. What advice can you give on following through with socially responsible investing?
- 3. How did the LS principles become part of Portfolio Advisory Board (PAB)? (In regard to this question, Patty will forward some info about the PAB.)
- 4. Can you suggest some assessment tools? What did it look like for you?
- 5. Do you have any comments on the letter to the Superior General, Fr. Joachim Rego?

Lissa will put these questions into a googledocs document, so we can reflect on them and make additions. We will finalize the questions at our next meeting (October 13th), and Patty will get them to Sr. Corinne in advance of the meeting with her.

Feedback from Fr. Joachim on Proposal submitted 8-11-20.

David shared a response he recently received from Fr. Joachim Rego to the "Proposal, A Program for the Passionist Family, Engaging Laudato Si', Renewal, Responsibility, Reimagining" Following is an excerpt:

I want to inform you that I presented the document to the General Council this past week for their comments and suggestions. All were more than satisfied with the structure, depth and breadth of the document, resulting in the Council's

agreement to proceed further. I have appointed 3 members of the Council to open a dialogue/conversation with the 3 of you as a next step. The three members are: Mirek Lesiecki (who is the JPIC liaison on the Council), Gwen Barde and Juan Ignacio Villar. In particular, the continuing dialogue among yourselves will concern the action steps which is indicated in your proposed program document in Section 6 – Appendix (Resources for Implementation).

David said that, in the future, when the above three-mentioned council members engage those who wrote the proposal, he would like to see the members of the LS VFT be part of the conversation, at the appropriate time.

Patty mentioned that the Lent 4.5 program is part of the implementation section, and many groups are starting to prepare for Lent soon. Is our Team expected to promote this? We will discuss at our next meeting.

The young adults might respond to the "Get Involved" link on the LS web page.

They may align with something already existing or a possible new program. The Catholic young adults would live out the principles of Laudato Si', and be paired with a Passionist member of a

local Catholic community. The emphasis is on the Passionist charism and Laudato Si'. Fr. Hugo is already doing this in Haiti. Meeting with mentors and fellow volunteers could be on Zoom.

Lissa shared some news from the minutes of the last Vision Fulfillment Commission (VFC) meeting regarding the December 2020 Leadership meeting:

The VFC discussed the format for the December gathering.
