Some highlights:

- Gather stakeholders in every area and brainstorm.
- Not so much strategic as a lot of ongoing conversations.
- Locate the people who are most passionate about LS and find out what will work for each community. Listen and engage.
- Find the people who are moving and get behind them; engage and keep talking with the others but don't make them your focus.
- Educate, educate, educate. Consistency and repetition. Educate at each step.
- Some potential assessment tools
 - Sierra Club
 - o Association of Schools in Higher Education
 - o Intercommunity Justice and Peace Center
- Develop feedback channels.
- How will you measure progress and successes?
- Examples of successes in their programs
 - Every 6 weeks a 1.5 hour presentation to all communities
 - Instagram as means of communication (as well as newsletters, Annual Report, etc.)
 - Summer program, 10 days, work on site & learn permaculture principles
- SRI Notes
 - Dee Joyner is chair of Portfolio Advisory Board and Director of Resilient Communities (efforts at SRI began in 70s)
 - Developed Dominican Sisters Climate Solutions Fund with Morgan Stanley
 - Suggested available tools to see carbon footprint of portfolio
 - o Divest vs retain ability to influence through shareholder meetings question
 - Sr. Corinne will send along names (Pat Daly [Dominican Sister of Caldwell NJ], Sr. Elise Garcia [Santuario Sisterfarm; on Advisory Committee for Dominicans' partnership with Morgan Stanley/Climate Solutions Fund]) who might be helpful.
