**I**nspired by Pope's Francis' call to take care of our Common Home, our Passionist family in Haiti is empowering Haitian Youth to reflect and articulate their position in the global task of finding harmony with the rest of creation.

“Although we see ourselves as part of the global movement, Generation Laudato Si' in Haiti has defined the values that will guide our efforts: prayer, advocacy, education and action. As young people from different Christian traditions we use the Word of God to guide us and shed light on the current global crisis we face. “Through the Word of God, we are engaged in educating ourselves by all means necessary to be able to understand our relationship with creation and to formulate an action plan according to our reality and desire to be good stewards of the resources in our care. “We also seek to share our acquired knowledge with our peers and neighbors in recognition of our interconnectedness and the witness we are to the love of Christ.”

### Since our project has begun, we have:

- ◆rescued over 300 sq. feet of land to use for our farm.
- ◆planted over 100 Maringa Oleifera Trees and Citronella Plants.
- ◆prepared 100 gallons of organic fertilizer.

### Our goals for 2020-2021 include:

- ◆rescuing 300 square feet of land to create a small plot for a community garden.
- ◆fundraising \$3000 USD for a system to capture rainwater for our gardens.
