Leader: We remember those women and men who currently serve you as consecrated religious and priests. May they be true gatekeepers, filled with joy, eager to share the Good News of Jesus with all. We pray: All: Lord, hear our prayer.

Leader: We remember those who have died. With gratitude for their lives and their vocations, we pray that they now experience life eternal with Jesus Christ and all holy men and women. We pray: All: Lord, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pause to remember our own special intentions. (Pause) We pray: **All:** *Lord, hear our prayer.*

Leader: Loving Father, we ask that you hear all our prayers: those spoken aloud, and those deep within our hearts. May we always listen to your voice, and by the grace of our vocation always share the love of Jesus Crucified with our world. In confidence, we pray as He has taught us:

All: Our Father....

We honor Mary, Our Mother as we pray:

All: Hail Mary...

Closing Prayer:

Jesus, our Crucified Lord and Savior, sent by the Father to reveal God's merciful love for all of creation, gift your Church with young men and women who are ready and eager to be living witnesses of your saving love and true servants of their sisters and brothers. We ask the intercession of the Holy Founder of the Passionists, St. Paul of the Cross, and all the holy men and women of history. As always, we pray through You, Christ our Lord. Amen.


All: Thanks be to God.
