# **Operations Report**

# <u>Staff</u>

- PPP LOAN: \$100,000 received to fund 14 of our employees. These funds will allow staff to be paid through June 15th. Terms of the loan: Furloughed staff needed to be back to 100% of their salaries, staff who are not onsite working, are receiving an average pay during this time.
- Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) a two week sick pay to any employee who applies. The funds from this program are offered through the federal government and are fully reimbursed after the close of the affected quarter.
- We currently have 5 staff members working on and offsite.
- Gene N., our part time landscaper is working on priorities mowing, watering, and blowing the grounds.
- Al F., our maintenance man, focuses his efforts on the HVAC system remodel and upgrade.

## Special Projects

• HVAC system upgrade: The Holy Cross Building approximately 85% complete. 3rd floor completed. The first and second floors are in process. We are anticipating the completion of the Holy Cross Building bedrooms by May 30.

### <u>Maintenance</u>

- Our front entrance gate continues to malfunction. We have put this project on hold.
- Sacramento County Fire District: We have completed several of the items on the checklist including our 5 year sprinkler inspection, inspecting all fire extinguishers, inspecting our fire hydrants, and inspecting and replacing batteries in all of the smoke detectors in the Chapel building. Many more items need to be addressed.
